## Checklist - College Student

Be sure to read all instructions carefully and have required information available before you begin the online application.

**DEADLINE FOR RECEIPT OF APPLICATIONS: Friday, February 9, 2018, 11:59 p.m.**

- Walpole Scholarship Foundation (WSF) College online application and essay**
  - Filled out by applicant with all questions answered.
  - Answered the correct essay question per your current year in college.
  
- Official College Transcript**
  - Allow two weeks for processing.
    - You must request a copy of your transcript from the Registrar of your school. You must then upload a scanned copy or picture of the transcript to the WSF online application. Do not submit a print-out of grades from the student portal.
  
- First page of the 2018-2019 FAFSA Student Aid Report (SAR)**
  - We recommend you file your FAFSA by January 29, 2018 to allow the Department of Education processing time to generate your SAR by WSF's deadline (2/9/18).
  - FAFSA is accessible October 1, 2017 – if your 2017 financial information is not available, you may use estimates based on 2016.
    - You must upload Page 1 of your SAR showing your name, address, and EFC. (See example on WSF website.)
    - You may blacken out any other information.
    - See separate instructions for filling out FAFSA on the WSF website.

***All financial information will be confidential.***

*Strict confidentiality will be observed in dealing with all financial information. The only financial information made available to the entire Scholarship Selection Committee will be the amount of "expected family contribution (EFC)."*
