DEADLINE FOR RECEIPT OF APPLICATIONS: Friday, February 9, 2018, 11:59 p.m.

Semi-finalists will be interviewed in Spring 2018. **Notification will be sent to the e-mail address that you provide in the application.**

- Walpole Scholarship Foundation (WSF) High School online application and essay**
 - Filled out by applicant with all questions answered.

Information uploaded by you to WSF online application:

- Official SAT or ACT score report**
 - SAT or ACT scores from the appropriate website – provide best scores. This report must include your full name. (See examples on WSF website.)
- First page of the 2018-2019 FAFSA Student Aid Report (SAR)**
 - We recommend you file your FAFSA by January 29, 2018 to allow the Department of Education processing time to generate your SAR by WSF's deadline (2/9/18).
 - FAFSA is accessible October 1, 2017 – if your 2017 financial information is not available, you may use estimates based on 2016.
 - Page 1 of your SAR showing your name, address, and EFC. (See example on WSF website.)
 - You may blacken out any other information.
 - See separate instructions for filling out FAFSA on the WSF website.

Information you request your Guidance Department to upload to WSF online application:

- The request is generated from within the WSF online application.
- We recommend you allow two weeks for processing.
- Official, Certified High School Transcript**
 - You will provide the name and email address of the Guidance staff member who will upload your transcript into the online application.
- Letter of Reference from Guidance Counselor or Teacher**
 - You will provide the name and email address of the Guidance staff member who will upload your letter of reference into the online application.

All financial information will be confidential.

Strict confidentiality will be observed in dealing with all financial information. The only financial information made available to the entire Scholarship Selection Committee will be the amount of "expected family contribution (EFC)."
